***A critical element of professional policing is ensuring the response to resistance we use is appropriate, legal, within policy, reviewed for improvement and enhanced training and supervised. Below is an abbreviated summary of the instances of our response to resistance to arrest:**

An officer responded to Circle K at Highway 50 and Bunkum Road to conduct a well-being check on a subject at the bus stop. The subject was found to be intoxicated and also had an active warrant. The subject resisted being handcuffed. As a result, the officer removed his taser and pointed it at the suspect but did not administer a tasing, who ultimately complied with the officer's verbal instructions.

Officers obtained the whereabouts of an Armed Vehicular Hijacking suspect from High Life. They responded to the suspect's residence and observed him enter. A perimeter of the residence was established and officers called the subject outside. Due to the nature of the offense, the officer displayed firearms. The subject was compliant and was taken into custody without incident.

An officer responded to a theft report from The Buckle. The officer canvassed the area and located the suspect hiding behind a vehicle in the parking lot of St. Clair Square. The officer removed his Taser, displayed it at the suspect (but did not administer a tasing) while giving verbal commands. The suspect got on the ground and was taken into custody.

An officer located an occupied stolen vehicle in Raising Cane's parking lot. Officers got into position and attempted a high-risk vehicle stop. All officers had their weapons unholstered and displayed. The suspect did not comply from their verbal request for the driver to exit the vehicle. They tactically approached and found the driver was sleeping inside. The subject was taken into custody without incident.

An officer located an occupied felony-wanted vehicle on Ashland Avenue. Officers coordinated and conducted a high-risk vehicle stop. All officers had their weapons unholstered and displayed. The vehicle's sole occupant complied with the officer's instructions and was taken into custody without incident. A vehicle search revealed a loaded firearm presumably used in an Aggravated Battery in St. Louis.
