***A critical element of professional policing is ensuring the response to resistance we use is appropriate, legal, within policy, reviewed for improvement and enhanced training and supervised. Below is an abbreviated summary of the instances of our response to resistance to arrest:**

While working secondary overtime at a local establishment, an officer was informed of a battery incident. The officer located the suspect, who then fled on foot to a vehicle. As a precaution, the officer drew his firearm while issuing verbal commands for the suspect to stop and exit the vehicle. The suspect fled the scene but was later apprehended and charged with Aggravated Battery. No injuries.

While conducting a patrol in the vicinity of State Route 161, an officer identified a vehicle that conducted a moving violation. The vehicle fled as the officer attempted to stop it. Ultimately, the vehicle stopped in the area of State Route 161 and Frank Scott Parkway. The officer employed high-risk vehicle stop tactics to take the individual into custody. These tactics involved displaying a firearm to ensure control and safety during the detention. The subject was subsequently charged with Fleeing and Eluding. No injuries.

Officers were dispatched to a domestic in progress, and upon arrival, the male involved party fled on foot from the scene. Officers gave chase and commanded the subject to stop. The subject refused and continued fleeing. Officers caught up to the subject and pointed their department-issued Tasers at the subject, who became compliant and was taken into custody. The subject was subsequently charged with Domestic Battery. No injuries.

Officers were dispatched to a local bar for a report of a battery. Upon arrival, they noticed a subject matching the suspect's description walking away from the scene. Officers contacted the subject and instructed him to stop. The suspect refused. Officers drew their department-issued Tasers and issued repeated commands. The subject became compliant and was taken into custody for Aggravated Battery. No injuries.

Officers responded to a report of a burning complaint on Pleasant Ridge Road. Upon arrival, they attempted to make contact with the complainant. While doing so, the officer heard one gunshot and took cover next to his squad car while summoning additional officers to respond. It was determined an occupant of the target house had fired a gun out of the window. A perimeter was established and the occupant was hailed over the loudspeaker to exit the residence. After an extended period, the subject exited. Officers adjacent to the residence, as a precaution, had their firearms displayed, and the subject was taken into custody. He was subsequently charged with Reckless Discharge of a Firearm. No injuries.

Officers responded to a local bar for a fight in progress. Upon arrival, an involved individual approached an officer's squad car and slammed his fists into the hood. The officer exited and commanded the subject to get on the ground. The subject's aggressive behavior compelled the officer to remove his department-issued Taser and continue to give the subject commands. The subject, albeit verbally aggressive, was taken into custody. As they attempted to escort the subject, he resisted and spit in the officer's face. The subject was taken to the ground and his legs were restrained. The subject was carried to an awaiting squad car. The subject was subsequently charged with Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer and Aggravated Battery in a Public Place. Several other subjects were also arrested for the fight.

Officers responded to a report of a violation of an order of protection where a male subject was in the process of setting fire to a vehicle at the residence and potentially shot a firearm. Upon arrival, officers were unsure where the subject was located but ultimately located him hiding in a sedan on the property. After multiple attempts to summon the suspect from the vehicle via loudspeaker and attempts to contact the suspect by phone, broke the vehicle's window with a bean bag round and deployed Pepperball into the vehicle. The subject surrendered and was taken into custody. Officers had their firearms drawn and pointed due to the potential the subject was armed. The subject was subsequently charged with multiple stalking-related offenses. No injuries.
