DIRECTOR'S REPORT/PROJECT UPDATES

The Director presented his written report to the elected officials for their review to which there were no questions or comments.

Aldersperson Peck questioned the status of Ashland Avenue and that she observed a crew marking today. The Director stated that Phase I from Old Collinsville Road to Joseph Drive is in design, as well as Phase II from Joseph Drive to Illinois Route 159.

The Director commented that the Old Collinsville Road project from Lincoln Highway to Ashland Avenue started in June. Aldersperson Poletti relayed that sections of curb and road are being removed and replaced with one lane open to traffic.

Aldersperson Poletti questioned if the improvements to I-64 and the Illinois Route 159 bridge over I-64 are on schedule? The Director replied that ramp construction is on schedule and the bridge is scheduled to start in July. He added that he will be closely monitoring the schedule/construction.

A motion and second was made to adjourn the Operations Meeting by Alderspersons Peck/Winkeler. All were in favor and the motion carried.
